Musical testament of the composer, Mozart's *Requiem* remains one of the cornerstones of the repertoire. Passion, tenderness, gravitas and gentleness interweave in the work, here performed by Kimy McLaren, Anita Krause, Colin Ainsworth, Tyler Duncan, the OSM Chorus (Andrew Megill, chorus director) and the Orchestra. Mozart's Symphony No. 25 and *Le Soleil des eaux*, with Rayanne Dupuis (soprano), choir and orchestra, one of Pierre Boulez's most important works, complete the program.
