KENT NAGANO CONDUCTS THE SCHUBERT FESTIVAL: A FIRST



To the Maestro's delight, the OSM plans to devote a festival series to the great Viennese composer Franz Schubert, in five different programmes across six concerts. Audiences are invited to discover the many facets of this composer through his signature works *Die schöne Müllerin* and *Winterreise*, and the complete symphonies conducted by **Kent Nagano**. **Angela Hewitt** (photo), **Paul Lewis** (photo), **Dietrich Henschel** and **Ian Bostridge** will perform lieder by this undisputed master of the genre. Also on the programme: selected works by Mozart, Rossini and Johann Strauss II, three major composers who influenced Schubert, will combine to transport audiences to classical, to the cosmopolitan Vienna, and to the frivolous Vienna that swirled to the music of the waltz! **JANUARY 12 TO 17 AT THE MAISON SYMPHONIQUE**

JANUARY 14, 2020: THE OSM CELEBRATES 85 YEARS!



The OSM's first concert took place on January 14, 1935, when the orchestra was known as *Société des concerts symphoniques de Montréal*. That inaugural performance was conducted by Rosario Bourdon at the concert hall adjoining Le Plateau School. For this anniversary performance, the OSM will offer an evening of quintessentially Viennese music: Schubert's Symphonies nos. 3 and 6, in which the spirit of Rossini still dwells, and arias by that master of Italian
