KENT NAGANO AND THE OSM KICKED OFF TOUR OF THE AMERICAS LAST NIGHT!

10 CITIES, 6 COUNTRIES, 12 CONCERTS, A SCREENING IN MEXICO OF ROGER FRAPPIER'S NEW DOCUMENTARY *CHAAKAPESH*, AS WELL AS SEVERAL ARTISTIC AND EDUCATIONAL ENGAGEMENTS ON THE AGENDA

Montreal, October 2, 2019— Last night, the OSM musicians and Kent Nagano kicked off the TOUR OF THE AMERICAS with an enthralling concert at Brazil's magnificent Sala São Paulo concert hall. They performed in front of a packed house for an enthusiastic audience who demanded two encores! A second concert will be presented in São Paulo tonight as part of this 55th tour—the 8th in Latin America—before the OSM and its conductor Kent Nagano continue on to other prestigious, world-renowned venues, including Teatro Municipal in Rio de Janeiro (October 3), Teatro Colón in Buenos Aires (October 7 and 8), Palacio de Bellas Artes in Mexico City (October 12) and the Symphony Center in Chicago (October 15). While Kent Nagano and the OSM's last tour in Latin America was in 2013, this year's tour marks the conductor's first appearances with the OSM in Chile (Centro de las Artes in Santiago, on October 5) and in Mexico. The OSM will also perform at the Festival Cervantino in Guanajuato, on October 11 to give a large-scale outdoor concert, and at the Sala Plácido Domingo (Conjunto Santander de Artes Escénicas) in Guadalajara, on October 13.

From October 1 to 15, the OSM will present a variety of programmes across Latin America with violinists **Simone Lamsma and Alexandra Soumm** and OSM Artist-in-Residence, pianist **Denis Matsuev** for its Chicago performance, featuring works by Brahms, Bartók, Mozart and Mahler. The **TOUR OF THE AMERICAS** will conclude in 2020 with two concerts in North America: first at **Roy Thomson Hall in Toronto** on February 19, after which, continuing a long-held tradition and pursuant to this year's invitation to New York, the Orchestra will give its 45th performance at the legendary **Carnegie Hall** on March 24.



WORLD PREMIERE OF THE FILM CHAAKAPESH

On October 10, in the auditorium of the University of Guanajuato in Mexico, filmmaker **Roger Frappier** of Max Films in collaboration with the OSM will present the grand premiere of his documentary on the OSM's recent tour of Quebec's Far North. The screening will be preceded by a talk with **Kent Nagano**, **Roger Frappier** and performer and throat singer **Akinisie Sivuarapik**, on the theme of "2019: International Year of Indigenous Languages," as proclaimed by the United Nations General Assembly.

Chaakapesh will be presented at the conclusion of the 48th Festival du nouveau cinéma (FNC), which takes place from October 9 to 20.



THE OSM IN THE COMMUNITY

And since music remains an extraordinary means of communicating and sharing across languages and borders, **Kent Nagano** and the musicians of the OSM propose a variety of artistic and educational activities on tour. Among other events, an orchestral workshop led by OSM musicians for the benefit of students in Santiago, and a talk in the Chilean capital featuring Maestro Nagano are planned. OSM Concertmaster **Richard Roberts** will present a masterclass at the Academia Orquestral de Buenos Aires. The orchestra's dress rehearsal in São Paulo will be open to the public, and students will be in attendance at an orchestral workshop given by our new Assistant Conductor **Thomas Le Duc-Moreau** in Guanajuato. Finally, 30 persons from under privileged communities, including a group of Venezuelan refugees, are invited to attend the concert in Rio de Janeiro on October 3.
